# DONCASTER ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

Bridon International Doncaster designs, manufactures and supplies steel wire, strand and ropes, designs rope terminations and provides an off site services function. All activities are within the scope of this policy statement.

It is the policy of Bridon International Doncaster to:

- operate the business so that, as a minimum it complies with National and International Environmental Legislation also the environmental requirements of third party organisations with which the Company is associated; exceeding these where possible within the constraints of the Company's ability to fund additional initiatives without compromising the financial security of the Company.
- ensure that employees are aware of the environmental aspects of their duties, to train them to manage environmental impacts and to encourage them to contribute towards environmental improvements.
- continuously seek to prevent pollution and ways of improving efficiency in order to minimise the consumption of materials, energy and other resources and to minimise waste and harmful emissions. Bridon will seek to recycle and reuse materials in order to minimise disposal and waste.
- encourage the use of environmentally responsible techniques in the supply chain, both upstream and downstream reduce the environmental impact of the Company's activities in partnership with customers and suppliers.
- establish objectives for environmental improvement and provide the resources necessary to progress and implement.
- maintain an independently certified environmental management system in accordance with ISO 14001 as a driver for continual improvement through the setting of objectives and industry best practice.
